

Privacy policy

Our principles regarding user privacy and data protection

- We believe user privacy and data protection are human rights
- We take protecting your privacy seriously, and we recognize we have a duty of care to the people whose data we hold
- We will only collect and process data when it is absolutely necessary, and when we do, we will make it clear why we are doing so and how it will be used

- We will not share your personal information with anyone else without your permission

Personal information collected (and why we collect it)

Personal data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data). GOP will process all personal data lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner. The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) sets out six lawful grounds for processing personal data, Golf Outing Pro (GOP) uses the first 4 listed. This website collects and uses personal information in the following ways, for the reasons specified:

1 Cookies and tracking site visitors

Like most websites this site makes use of cookies, which are small amounts of textual data that are stored on the device (computer, mobile phone, tablet etc.) that you use to access our website. This data is used to enhance your experience of this site.

Cookies may be set and accessed by third-party data processors, including Google Analytics (GA). We use this data to monitor how many people are using our site and to better understand how they use the site, in order to improve the experience we provide. Although GA records information such as your geographical location, device, internet browser and operating system, none of this data personally identifies you to us.

Disabling cookies on your internet browser will stop this site from tracking any part of your visit to this website. You can set your browser not to accept cookies. However, some of our website features may not function correctly as a result.

Clicking any link on our website is taken as implied consent to our placing cookies on your device, unless you have disabled them in your browser as described above.

2 Uses made of information

We use personal information held about you:

- As part of our efforts to keep our website safe and secure
- To administer our website and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and research purposes
- To personalize and optimize your experiences as part of our provision of the service
- To provide you with our service and to communicate with you in respect of your use of the service.
